Thanks to those that do and it is appreciated! For those that need a little nudge—there is City Ordinance No. 1, Series 2006. Please read it and get familiar with the penalties.



Another area of concern, are the yard sale signs posted on City property. Ordinance 2, Series 1977 states that no sign or poster of any kind shall be affixed to any street sign or any pole which is the property of the City. The use of tape results in damage to the pole when the tape is removed and the paint comes off with it. Remember that your address is listed on the improperly placed sign and is noticed by many.
