DID YOU KNOW THAT 50 MILLION AMERICANS SUFFER FROM SEASONAL ALLERGIES?

Hallmarks of seasonal allergies are sneezing; itchy eyes, nose, & throat; runny nose & eyes; and post-nasal drip.

Allergens – or things you are allergic to – trigger an allergic reaction. In the Spring, tree pollens are the primary source of allergies and includes trees such as alder, birch, oak, poplar and willow.

How can you avoid or minimalize seasonal allergies? There are lifestyle behaviors you can do to reduce your exposure to allergens.

- Don't expose yourself to triggers by staying indoors on windy or high pollen-count days.
- Clean the air you breathe by vacuuming, using air conditioning and changing your furnace filters regularly.
- Try over-the-counter medications such as decongestants and antihistamines which can help alleviate discomfort.

SCAM ALERT

Watch out! Scammers target everyone.





Recognize scammers. They may:

- PRETEND to be from an agency or organization you know.
- Say there's a **PROBLEM** or promise a prize.
- PRESSURE you to act immediately.
- Tell you to PAY in a specific way.



Do not give scammers money or personal information – Ignore them!

How to avoid a scam:

- Remain calm. Talk to someone you trust.
- Hang up or ignore the message. DO NOT click on links or attachments.
- Protect your money. Criminals will insist that you pay in a hard-to-trace manner, such as with a gift card, prepaid debit card, cryptocurrency, wire transfer, money transfer, or by mailing cash.
- **Protect your personal information.** Be skeptical of a contact you didn't initiate.
- Spread the word. Share your knowledge of Social Security-related scams. Post on social media using the hashtag #SlamtheScam to share your experience and warn others. Visit ssa.gov/scam for more information. Please also share with your friends and family.




This Summer!
